Check-In

4-H Poultry may be checked in **Thursday, September 10 from 2:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.** (Enter at Gate 1 located on Poplar Street and then you know you are dropping off Poultry. Please exit at Gate 9.) or **Friday, September 11 from 9:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m.** (Enter at Gate 10 located on Plum Street) and let the gate staff know you are here to drop off your 4-H Poultry exhibit(s). You will need a gate admission ticket.

Health Requirements

- Chickens/turkeys that have been P/T tested within 90 days of the Kansas State Fair should provide the P/T testing certificate at check-in.
- All chickens and turkeys not P/T tested at their local fair will be tested at check-in. If your birds need tested, please email knordyke@ksu.edu with the exhibitor's name, Extension unit, and number of birds that need tested by 5pm Thursday, September 3, 2026.

Judging Day

- Judging will take place Saturday, September 6 beginning at 8:00 a.m. 4-H'ers may be present during judging, but are not required to do so.

Poultry Exhibit Release

- All 4-H Poultry will be released from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. the last Sunday of the fair. Cages must be vacated by 7:00 p.m.
- Enter at gate #10 on Plum Street and get a delivery release hang tag. You will not need a gate ticket at gate #10 to pick up animals.
- You may need to park in the purple lot behind the livestock barns and walk in to the poultry barn with crates and/or cages.
- Please note that all other 4-H exhibits in 4-H Centennial Hall will not be released until 6:00 p.m.
