Pawnee County 4-H Shooting Sports will be hosting a state qualifier for Small Bore Pistol, Small Bore Rifle and Muzzleloading. All 4-H shooters entering the competition must have completed instruction in their home county 4-H Shooting Sports program for the discipline entered. Shooters 4-H age 12-18 are invited to participate in Muzzleloading; Shooters 4-H age 10-18 are invited to participate in Small Bore Rifle and 4-H Age 12-18 for Small Bore Pistol. The 2024 4-H Fall State Match Rules for Small Bore Pistol/Rifle and Muzzleloading will be observed. There will be no awards beyond qualifying for the state match.

The minimum age to PARTICIPATE at the State Match is 4-H age 12 years old before January 1, 2024

MAIL ENTRY FORM AND FEES BY Wednesday, July 31, 2024 to: Pawnee County 4-H Shooting Sports, c/o Sabrina Lange, 715 Broadway #6, Larned, KS 67550. Late registrations will be accepted to fill relays only. Fees will be \$10.00 per shooter, per discipline and may be paid day of competition. We will only accept registration form from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Entries limited to: SBR- 8 entries; MZ- 4 entries; SBP-8 entries.

Small Bore Rifle: (First relay 9 a.m.) Qualifying Course of Fire: A/51 Targets: Shoot 3x10 course of fire at 50 yards to include 10 shots each in prone (1 min per record shot), standing (2 min per record shot), and kneeling (1.5 min per record shot). Targets will be changed after each position. **To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 175 out of 300 possible.**

Muzzleloading: (First relay 9 a.m.) Qualifying Course of Fire: TG2406 target: Shoot 10 shots at 50 yards – 8 ring targets; and TG2427 target: Shoot 10 shots at 25 yards – bottle target. **To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 75 points out of a possible 200.**

Small Bore Pistol: (First relay 10:45 a.m., or as soon as Muzzleloading is finished.)
Qualifying Course of Fire: 25-yard range distance: Slow fire – B16 target; 10 minutes for 10 shots Timed fire – B8 target, 20 seconds per string of 5, 2 strings of 5 Rapid fire – B8 target, 10 seconds per string of 5, 2 strings of 5. **To qualify for the State Match, the minimum individual score is 125 out of 300 possible.**

There will be no concession stand. Water will be provided.
