COST: First bow \$10, Second bow \$10

Juniors (9-13) will shoot 12 arrows each at 20 & 30 meters Seniors (14-18) will shoot 12 arrows each at 30 & 40 meters

To qualify for the State Match, participants must be 9-18 years old before January 1, 2025 and obtain a minimum FITA qualifier score of:

Recurve - **120** out of 240 possible points Olympic - **140** out of 240 possible points Compound/Bow Hunter - **200** out of 240 possible points Compound/Open - **210** out of 240 possible points
