Midway District 4-H Shooting Sports will be hosting a shooting sports match for shotgun, shooting trap only. This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 10-18.

Awards will not be given, this is only a state qualifier. No Concession stand.

Note: The minimum age to participate at the State Match is 10 years old before January 1, 2026.

Registration form is due by 5 pm, August 25, 2026. Registration Fees are \$20 per shooter, pay the day of the event.

Late registrations only accepted to fill relays. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. We will squad and assign times for the shooters, which will be sent to the county after registration is completed. Registration begins at 9:30 a.m. The match will begin at 10:00 a.m. Shooters may be divided up into different times depending on the number of participants. Each county needs to verify their shooters information when checking in for correct age and discipline. Please check in approximately 30 minutes before scheduled times. Shooters will need to bring equipment and shells - NO RELOADS. No barrels resting on toes, foot or pointed at any part of the body! Ammunition Specifications: New shells, no larger than 12 ga. with a maximum shot size of 7 1/2 lead shot and a maximum shot charge of 1 1/8 oz.

Shotgun Trap: Shooters will shoot 2 rounds of 25 for a total of 50 at 16 yards. The shooters will shoot 5 shots in each of 5 positions, take a short break between each round of 25 shots. The 50 shots (2 rounds) will be the qualifying score as per State Match rules. Current ATA and 2025 Kansas State Match Rules apply. To qualify for the State Match in Shotgun Trap, the minimum individual score is 35 out of 50.

Directions to Sportsman Club: 1.5 miles west of Ellsworth on Highway 40 and 1.5 miles north on 13th Rd.
